

DOT THE I (a drama)

The action of "Dot the I" takes place in the Girondin's apartment near the Arc de Triomphe, in Paris, 1936. This play explores three liberal minded adults' attempt to live a three-way marriage. The poignant surprise ending raises "haunting" questions inviting inquiry and reflection long after the final curtain falls.

THE DOUBLE EXPERTISE (a comedy)

The action occurs in an elegant bachelor apartment in Paris, 1937. This light-hearted comedy engages the familiar themes of match-making schemes gone awry and concealed identities embarrassingly revealed. Although a comedy it brings to light serious questions about grounds for matrimonial compatibility and for lasting commitments or what Marcel calls "creative fidelity."
